## Campground Rules

---

### Hours

#### Check In & Out

- Check In: 3pm
- Check Out: 11am

#### Quiet Hours

- Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM
- All visitors must leave the campground by quiet time.

### Financial

#### Holds & Deposits

- Prior to the start of the camping season, a \$100 deposit is required to hold a site.
- Monthly deposits are nonrefundable.
- During the camping season, there are no holds or deposits. The full balance must be paid upon reservation.

#### Refunds

- 15 or more days before reservation: full refund
- 4-14 days before:
  - Daily reservation: cost for one day (\$20/36/42/57)
  - Monthly/weekly: 10% of total reservation
- 3 or less days before: no refund
- Holiday: no refund

### Occupancy

- A tent may not occupy a site for more than 15 consecutive nights. After this period, the tent may not return for a minimum of 5 days.
- Each campsite is limited to one family or a maximum of four unrelated persons.
- Campers not part of a family must be at least 18 years old to occupy a site, unless part of a chaperoned group (e.g., scouts, cyclists).
- Unsupervised minors may not occupy a campsite.

### Vehicles

- 5 MPH on all roads.
- Motor vehicles must be licensed and may only park in designated areas.

- Vehicle repairs, washing, or maintenance are prohibited unless approved by the Campground Manager.

## Conduct

- Violent, abusive, loud, boisterous, profane, obscene, or disorderly conduct is prohibited and will result in immediate removal without a refund.
- No fireworks, firecrackers, or explosive materials are permitted in the park.
- Firearms and weapons must comply with Michigan law and DNR regulations.
- No littering - dispose of all wastewater in the dump station.
- No glass containers near the lake.
- Per Michigan law, cannabis may only be used in private (inside your camper or tent).

## Property & Vegetation

- Do not destroy, damage, or remove any city trees, shrubs, wildflowers, grasses, or vegetation.
- Hammocks, shade sails, and laundry lines must not be hazardous or penetrate trees.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times when using campground-owned watercraft.

## Waste & Sanitation

- Gray water must only be emptied in the designated dump station.
- No washing dishes in the bathhouse, at water pumps, or near any drinking water source.
- Campers must keep their campsite clean. All wastewater must be disposed of into the dump station.

## Campfires

- Outside wood is allowed, but we encourage buying from campground to keep camping rates down. Truckloads of wood are not permitted.
- Fires must be kept in the designated fire rings or grills.
- Burning trash is strictly prohibited (e.g., bottle caps, plastic, styrofoam).
- Never leave fires unattended - ensure they are fully extinguished before leaving.

## Pets

- All pets must always be on a leash no longer than 6 feet and under owner control.
- Pet waste must be picked up and disposed of in the dumpster.
- Pets must be secured in an enclosed vehicle or tent at night.
- Pets are not allowed in the bathhouse.
- Excessive noise or aggressive behavior may result in removal from the campground without a refund.

## Enforcement

- Violation of these rules or of Beaverton City park ordinances may result in removal from the campground without a refund, at the discretion of the Campground Manager.
